Context and background

- Reliable, sustainable energy is key to development in Africa.
 - More than 590 million people in 2021 lack electricity access in Africa, with only 17% of the population with access to clean cooking in Sub-Saharan Africa. Trends are worsening due to the covid19 pandemic
 - Africa is behind with regard to deployment and investment (in 2019 only 2% of the new renewable energy capacity installed in Africa)
 - A change of direction is needed to harness the potential of renewable energy and energy efficiency.
- Reinforced EU partnership with Africa to support this transformation, aligned with Agenda 2063, the 2030 Agenda and the Paris Agreement:
 - The Africa-EU Green Energy Initiative will promote strategic and concerted actions: (a) policy dialogue; (b) capacity building; (c) technical assistance (d) support to leveraging private investments and (d) reinforce Africa-EU business and technology cooperation.
- The EABF event will serve to exchange views on how to accelerate the green energy transition in Africa, including:
 - Key challenges and opportunities, in the context of the covid19 crisis.
 - Inform and pave the way for substantive engagement ahead of the EU-AU Summit.
- EABF marketplace: Private sector key to bridge the energy gap in a sustainable way
